CREEKSIDE OPEN 2017 selected by Jordan Baseman and Alison Wilding

The two CREEKSIDE OPEN exhibitions will be shown at the A.P.T Gallery in London and the work will be selected from one submission.

Artists are invited to apply by submitting digital images of work that has been made since May 2015. The single submission from which two shows will be independently selected will offer artists two chances of exhibiting at the A.P.T Gallery on Creekside, London.

Eligibility

The CREEKSIDE OPEN 2017 is open to artists living or working in the UK. Applications are welcome from visual artists working in all media. The submitted works must have been made since May 2015. Only one entry per person is allowed. Each entry comprises three works. Members and employees of A.P.T are not allowed to enter.

Entry Procedure

Applications can be made:

- Online : the application form can be completed and three images uploaded to the CREEKSIDE OPEN website database. Payment will be made online. If you are submitting film, video or audio projects please apply by post or by hand.
- By post : the application form can be downloaded from the website and sent to A.P.T with the images stored on a memory stick.
- By hand : the completed entry can be delivered to A.P.T.

The Selectors will consider all three images and, if selected, one of the three works will be included in the exhibition. All work is viewed anonymously so please ensure that your name does not appear on any of your images or film and sound credits. Any entry that has been named will be disqualified. The Selectors will view the submissions independently, so each artist will have two opportunities to be selected for the CREEKSIDE OPEN 2017.

Image Requirements

- Jpeg images to be uploaded to the CREEKSIDE OPEN Database: 72dpi, 1000 pixels or 8.5cm wide, maximum size 600 KB
- Jpeg images saved to a memory stick : 72dpi, 1000 pixels or 8.5cm wide, maximum size 600 KB (Please do not create a Powerpoint slideshow or insert images into a PDF document)
- Film / video / audio: Please submit a two minute excerpt **and** the complete film on a memory stick. If the excerpt exceeds two minutes the submission will be disqualified. Please ensure that the film title and credits on both the excerpt and complete film does not include your name.

Entry Fee

£21 for one entry of three pieces of work.

All unclaimed memory sticks will be destroyed in August 2017.
